

Governance Committee

Authority

1. The Committee is established under ARTICLE VIII: COMMITTEES & TASK FORCES of the bylaws approved July 22, 2023.

Membership

- 1. Committee members are limited to the Board of Trustees and will no less than three (3) individuals selected and appointed by the President.
- 2. The Committee shall have a Chair and Vice-Chair selected by the President.

Operations

- 1. Meetings shall be scheduled as needed.
- 2. The Committee shall meet either virtually, by telephone conference, or in-person as needed.
- 3. Two-thirds of the members constitute a quorum to conduct a meeting.
- 4. The Chair shall record and keep minutes of meetings.

Responsibilities

- 1. Develop a recruitment strategy for members to the Board of Trustees, considering desired skill sets and diverse perspectives;
- 2. The Committee shall provide a slate of candidates for Board discussion and approval;
- 3. Develop and ensure appropriate implementation of Board orientation and onboarding strategies;
- 4. Develop and maintain a Board member manual;
- 5. Periodically review the governing documents of the organization and whether they are consistent with applicable laws and actual or desired organizational practices; and
- 6. Review the performance of the Board and Committees, including the effectiveness of meetings, and make recommendations as appropriate.
